

What is Silver Springs?

Located on the fringe of the Great Dividing Range, *Silver Springs* is a property ranging over 1,000 acres of former grazing land that has been repurposed to enable a carbon sequestration and biodiversity program to protect native Australian flora and fauna.



How does it work?

Proper land utilisation is essential to a more sustainable future. By repurposing land that is less suited to its former agricultural purpose to conservational territory, Silver Springs acts as a means of 'paying it forward'.

Silver Springs is committed to planting over 100,000 native trees from seeds sourced on the property itself. By becoming carbon positive, the Silver Springs scheme offers businesses, stakeholders and individuals to purchase **carbon credits** to offset the carbon they produce.

Silver Springs has also applied this concept to their **biodiversity credits** scheme, which allows stakeholders to purchase biodiversity credits to offset their impact. Developers of wind farms, mines, or any business clearing habitat which is equivalent to the property can neutralise the impact of their project on the environment.

Both carbon and biodiversity credits are available for purchase.
