Rules of Proceedings

THOUGHT LEADER PANEL

- The Session Chair introduces each Thought Leader and sets the scene.
- Each Thought Leader will present for 7 minutes. Their role is to give a thought-provoking address and initiate an informed discussion.

ZOOM DISCUSSION

- The Facilitator is responsible for calling on participants who would like to participate in discussion.
- Each participant (including Session Chairs and Thought Leaders answering questions) has **up to 3 minutes** to speak.
- Participants can indicate their intention to speak to the Facilitator by clicking the **'Raise Hand'** button in the 'Participants' tab, or typing **'request to speak'** in the public Zoom Chat window.
- Participants should briefly introduce themselves before speaking.
- Participants are encouraged to keep their video on at all times during discussion and stay on mute unless invited to speak.
- Discussion at the Virtual Event will be held under the Chatham House Rule of **non-attribution**. We respectfully request you refrain from tweeting or messaging via social media during the discussion times.
