Guidelines for Authors

Authors can submit their manuscripts via <https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/GCRS>

Authors will need to create an account for *GCRS* and follow the on-screen instructions.

Step-by-step: Submitting to *GCRS* via ScholarOne

Go to the journal's ScholarOne site

- On the Emerald *GCRS* journal page, click **Submit your paper**
- This takes you to the ScholarOne login page for that specific journal

Create or log into your ScholarOne account

- If you already have a ScholarOne account for another Emerald journal, you may still need to **create a new account** because each journal has its own site
- Fill in your profile details (name, affiliation, email, ORCID)

Start a new submission

- On your **Author Dashboard**, click **"Start New Submission"**
- ScholarOne will open a multi-step submission wizard

The ScholarOne Submission Wizard (the actual screens)

Step 1: Type, Title & Abstract

- Choose the correct type (e.g., *Research Article, Review, Viewpoint*)
- Paste **title** and **abstract** into the fields (*Purpose, Design/methodology/approach, Findings, Research limitations/implications, Practical implications, Social implications, Originality/value*)
- Click **Save & Continue**

Step 2: File Upload

- Upload your manuscript as **Anonymous Article File** (no author names or identifying details; must include structured abstract and keywords)
- Upload additional files only if needed:
 - **Tables** (if not in manuscript)
 - **Figures** (high quality, 300 dpi)
 - **Supplementary material** (datasets, appendices, etc.)

NB: All tables and figures must include a source line: *Source: Authors own work*

- Select correct file type and set file order
- Check preview (PDF/HTML) before continuing
- Click **Save & Continue**

Step 3: Keywords

- Enter **keywords** (required 2, maximum 6)
- Click **Save & Continue**

Step 4: Authors & Institutions

- Add all authors one by one. For each author you must enter:
 - Full name
 - Email
 - Affiliation
 - Country
 - ORCID (if available)
- Tick the box for **Corresponding Author**
- Click **Save & Continue**

Step 5: Reviewers

- Suggest up to three (3) reviewers.
 - Provide name, affiliation and professional email for each
 - Brief note on expertise and relevance
 - Avoid anyone with a conflict of interest
 - Reviewers must be independent (no collaborators, co-authors or close associates)
 - The editorial team retains final selection
- Click **Save & Continue**

Step 6: Details & Comments

- Paste or upload a short **cover letter** explaining:
 - Why the paper fits GCRS
 - What the contribution is
 - That the work is original and not under review elsewhere
- Complete all required declarations. You will be asked to confirm:
 - originality and exclusive submission
 - ethics compliance
 - anonymisation of the manuscript
 - conflicts of interest and funding
 - AI use (if applicable)
 - case study / identifiable organisation
 - human or animal research (if applicable)
- Answer all required questions, then **Save & Continue**

Step 7: Review & Submit

You'll see a summary page showing:

- All metadata
- All uploaded files
- All declarations

Check everything carefully. If something is missing, ScholarOne will highlight it in red

Submit

- Click "Submit"
- Wait for the confirmation screen
- You'll receive a confirmation email with a manuscript ID (e.g., GCRS-2026-1234)

After submission

- Your dashboard will show the status (e.g., *Submitted*, *With Editor*, *Under Review*)
- You can log in anytime to track progress or upload revisions if requested
